Broadband Location Reporting *Update*

As we noted in the December 16, 2016 *Special Bulletin*, rate-of-return regulated carriers are required to report certain broadband location data on or before March 1, 2017:

- ⇒ **ACAM support recipients** are required to report all locations deployed to (10/1 mbps, etc) during 2016 (Jan 1—Dec 31). In addition, by March 1, 2019, ACAM support recipients will be required to report all locations served as of January 1, 2016.
- ⇒ **CAF BLS recipients** are required to report all locations deployed to during the period May 25, 2016 through December 31, 2016. Furthermore, only CAF recipients with less than 80% 10/1 deployment (as measured [here](#)) - those with specific CAF BLS broadband buildout obligations—are required to report any locations served by March 1, 2017. *Carriers showing greater than 80% deployment should not report anything.*
- ⇒ **Alaska Plan** carriers will report locations newly served during 2017 by March 1, 2018.

It is important to note that “locations” are any served with at least 4/1, 10/1, and 25/3 mbps broadband service. For more information on the definition of locations, please see the Wireline Competition Bureau’s December [Public Notice](#).
